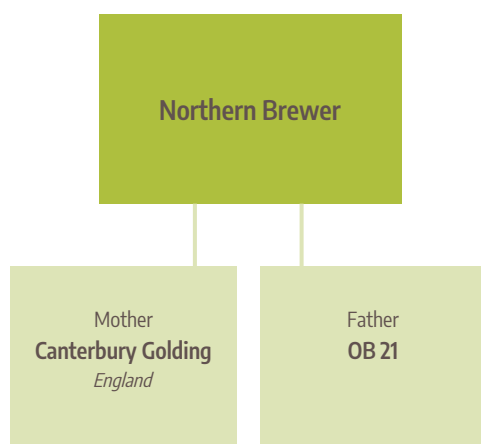




NORTHERN BREWER

Pedigree



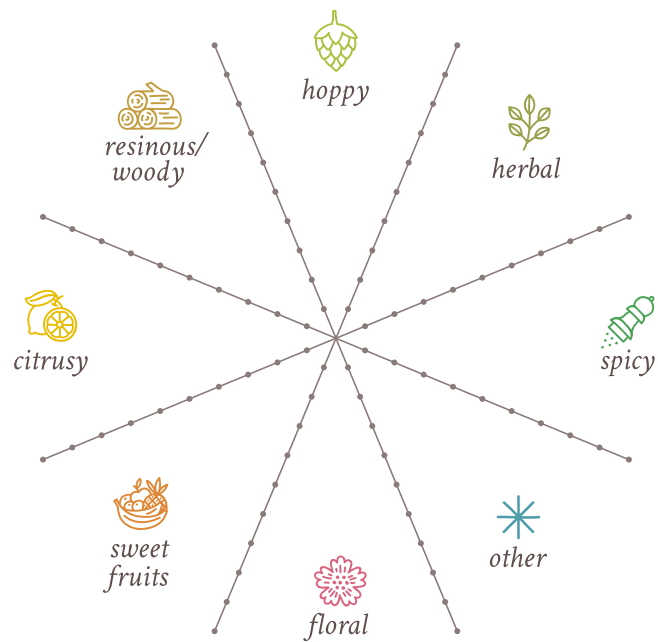
